### (Help Over-Population End)

The Hendricks County Humane Society HOPE Program offers low cost pet sterilization. HCHS does not contribute any additional funds to the veterinarians who participate; their sole reimbursement is the amount paid for the certificate. This program is honored by the veterinarians listed on the back. You do not have to be a resident of Hendricks County to participate. If your pet is **not** current on vaccinations, you must include these on the day of surgery. If your pet is current, bring proof the day of surgery. To participate in this program, please fill out the attached application; one application is required for each pet. Please contact the HCHS Office at the number below for more information.

1. Upon receipt of your application(s), HCHS will mail to you one HOPE certificate per each pet application.
2. You must make, and keep, an appointment with one of the participating veterinarians (below); tell them you are using the HOPE certificate. Certificates expire 3 months from the date of issue; the fee for unused certificates (not redeemed within the 3 months) is forfeited, unless alternate arrangements are made prior to the expiration date.
3. When calling to schedule the appointment, be sure to ask if there are any specific tests or screenings required before a surgery can be performed, such as FIV, HIV/AIDS, fecal or blood work. (Usually such tests are suggested but not required.) You will be responsible for the cost of any additional tests that you choose.
4. Take the HOPE certificate with you to the veterinarian, on the date of your pet's surgery. Also, if your pet is up-to-date with vaccinations, be sure to bring documentation of this with you as well.
5. Any animal can be excluded from surgery at the veterinarian's discretion, for medical reasons such as but not limited to: old age, disease, or late stage pregnancy.
6. If you are unable to keep your scheduled appointment, please give the veterinarian's office 24 hours notice. Failure to do so may invalidate your certificate.
